Call for Submission of Applications for Doctoral Fellowship Funding in Energy Science and Technology at Eduardo Mondlane University (1st edition)

Within the scope of promoting University Excellence by supporting teaching in Postgraduate Courses in Oil and Gas Engineering and Technology, and related areas, the Center of Studies in Oil and Gas Engineering and Technology (CS-OGET) announces that the call for the Doctoral Fellowship Funding is open for students who intend to pursue research in Energy Science and Technology at the Eduardo Mondlane University.

PERIOD COVERED BY THE SCHOLARSHIP

The funding will cover a period of three (3) years, counting from the application approval date. Its renewal at the end of the first year of the course, is guaranteed upon presentation of satisfactory academic progress, supported by the declaration of subject's completion or research report.

AVAILABILITY OF SCHOLARSHIPS AND TYPE

- a) The total number of scholarships available is six (6), being two (2) full scholarships for regional students and four (4) scholarships for national students.
- b) The Full Scholarship comprises the following benefits:

- Tuitions Fees;
 - Accommodation;
 - Monthly allowance;
 - Research support (Doctoral Thesis);
 - Doctoral Thesis Fees; and
 - Field work support.
- c) The reduced Scholarship comprises the following benefits:
- Tuitions Fees;
 - Research support (Doctoral Thesis);
 - Doctoral Thesis Fees; and
 - Field work support.

BENEFICIARIES

- a) Students enrolled in the Doctoral Programme in Energy Science and Technology at Eduardo Mondlane University.

REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICATION

- a) Proof of registration or letter of acceptance in the Postgraduate Programme;
- b) Demonstrate a genuine need for financial support to pursue the studies;
- c) Not be a beneficiary of any other form of Scholarship;
- d) Be available to provide services to CS-OGET during the study period;
- e) Average of the Master's course equal to or greater than 14 (on the scale in use at the UEM or equivalent (0 – 20));
- f) Exceptionally, candidates with an average of not less than 12 may benefit from the scholarship, provided they have at least 3 years of professional experience in an area considered relevant for the Doctoral Programme indicated above.

PROCEDURES FOR THE APPLICATION

The application is made by submitting the following documents:

- a) Letter addressed to the Director of CS-OGET and other documents considered relevant to support the application;
- b) Proof of registration or letter of acceptance in the Postgraduate Programme;
- c) Authenticated copy of the Certificate/Diploma of Completion of the Master's course or equivalent.

BENEFICIARIES SELECTION CRITERIA

- a) The selection will be made on a competitive basis, mainly taking into account the limited number of scholarships to be awarded;
- b) The criteria for evaluation will be fundamentally based on the evaluation of the academic record at Master's level or equivalent, on the relevance of the research topic to be developed and on the financial condition presented by the candidate.

DEADLINES FOR SUBMISSION

The application must be delivered to the CS-OGET secretariat, located in the Postgraduate building of the Faculty of Engineering at UEM, during office hours between June 11th and July 15th, 2023. Alternatively, they can be sent electronically through the email addresses provided below. It should be noted that this process is independent of the application to attend the Doctoral Programme, which must be done in accordance with the deadlines in force in the Doctoral Programme.
