### INVITATION FOR BIDS

The Government of Rwanda has received a loan from the World Bank into the project named Priority Skills Growth (PSG) under which the University of Rwanda (UR) is implementing the development and delivery of high quality and market-relevant (new or updated) academic programs in 3 sectors: Transport and Logistic, Energy and Agro-Processing. Therefore, upgrading of teaching, learning facilities and ICT Enabled pedagogies in the above three sectors is required.

The tendering process will be made in two stages by international competition:

- For the **first stage**, all interested bidders will submit their technical offers,
  - Provide company profile, demonstrate technical capacity, key staff, financial capacity and proof of experience executed in the last years ;
  - provide technical comment on the list equipment/ items identified by client;
  - Provide comment on technical and function specifications of equipment, materials and softwares prepared by client;
  - provide comment on the terms of references prepared by the client;
  - Provide methodologies of works, for design, installation and training to be provided;
  - Propose the new list and technical specifications of items/ equipment to be supplied and installed.
- For the **second stage**, the selected bidders will receive the final tender document and be invited for submitting their bids (technical and financial).

Now, for this stage, University of Rwanda invites eligible competent bidders to submit their technical offers for Upgrading of teaching and learning facilities and ICT Enabled pedagogies at UR; "Design, Supply, Installation of Smart classrooms and smart laboratories, virtual laboratories and Provide ICT skills and innovative pedagogical trainings.

1. The detailed terms of reference, list of equipment, materials and softwares and their function and technical specifications proposed will be found in the bidding document;
2. The financial offer will not be submitted for this stage; only technical offer will be submitted;
3. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information and the bidding documents in Umucyo e- procurement system from 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2021;
4. Bids prepared and signed must be submitted through **Umucyo E-Procurement system**; no bids will be submitted outside of the Umucyo E-



Procurement System. Therefore, any interested bidder **MUST BE REGISTERED** in Umucyo E-Procurement System through **[www.umucyo.gov.rw/supplier](http://www.umucyo.gov.rw/supplier)** registration;
